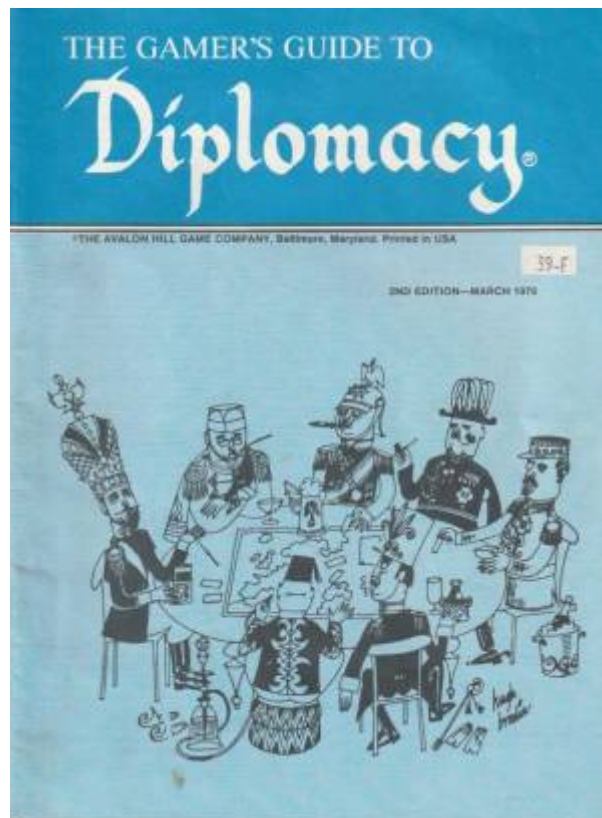


The Gamer's guide to Diplomacy

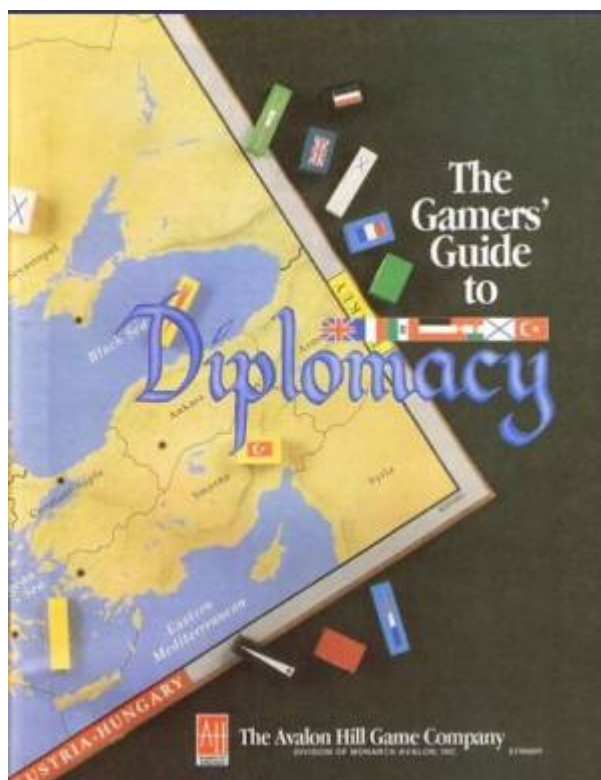
Le "*Gamer's guide to Diplomacy*" est un guide de 36 page pour jouer a Diplomacy

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<i>Biographical Note</i>	
The author has played DIPLOMACY since 1911 and has been involved in postal DIPLOMACY since 1948. From 1960 to 1970 he published a postal DIPLOMACY publication, DIPLOMAT, as well as several other rules, to all the time, and published more than 1000 notes relating to DIPLOMACY. In addition, his notes on the game have been widely printed in other publications. He was Secretary of the British Board of Diplomacy from 1960 to 1971, and in the same time undertaking several other jobs. During 1970-1971 he was a member of the ad hoc committee which resulted in writing the Rules. From 1960 to 1971 he wrote a regular column on DIPLOMACY for the professional magazine, Journal of Diplomacy & Strategy. He is presently Secretary of Diplomacy (UK).	
Mr. Walker holds degrees in Law (Barrister) and Political Science. He has specialised in the foreign relations and diplomatic history of the United States and the United Nations. He currently resides in southern California working as a writer. He has many strategic thinking books, mainly for the Country of the Dragon, and a 2-3-5 strategy series, specialising in Europe and United Nations. His work has appeared in the pages of various magazines and the American newspaper. He has written several books, which should be his last in the DIPLOMACY series, but he has written many more.

In order to save space, the following codes, which are standard, have been used for all games. The three letters in brackets, which are in the Rules (1911), will be used to abbreviate the following (Diplomacy used in postal play) will be used to avoid any possible confusion:	
A.C. → Capital of Britain G.L. → Gulf of Lyons T.Y. → Turkey T.C. → Constantinople L.A. → London L.S. → Lyons
