Regional tournaments would be a single round, either at a con or housecon in the nine mont leading up to MidCon, the game terminating in 1911. You could play in more than one regional tournament. If you don't pre-qualify for the NDC then you can still play at MidCon, but if you win you will only collect the MidCon Trophy, not the NDC itself. Regional qualifiers were announced for Exeter, Oxford, Burton on Trent, Brighton, Birmingham and Nottingham (all held within other games cons) and other housecons were also added soon thereafter.
